

CCT Temperature Screening Kiosk (MA)

Purpose:

To screen employees before their shift to identify anyone that may be sick, suffering from Coronavirus disease (COVID-19), or be infected with severe acute respiratory syndrome coronavirus 2 (SARS-CoV-2).

Note: This is for employees reporting onsite daily or on a routine schedule. Contractors, visiting, and non-routine employees must contact adesimone@coldchaintech.com before their visit and complete the COVID-19 Questionnaire. Upon arrival, they will then use the appropriate kiosk.

Procedure:

There are temperature screening kiosks located in the west employee entrance for all Area B & C employees and inside the main front door for 1st and 2nd floor Area A employees.

1. The employee must keep their mask on and stand in front of the kiosk screen. **There is no need to touch the screen for any reason.**
 - a. The unit will advise if an employee needs to move closer or further away to be scanned.
2. The kiosk will scan and announce the employee's temperature.
 - a. A passing temperature will be reported as "Normal Temperature" with a green visual indicator. The employee is ok to report to work.
 - b. A high temperature will be reported as "Abnormal Temperature" with a red indicator on the screen, and the employee should take another reading.
 - c. If they fail, again, they will need to be scanned with a handheld thermometer. Contact your supervisor or Tony DeSimone at 401-447-6937.
 - i. **If it is 100°F and above, please notify Plant Manager and HR immediately. The employee cannot report for their shift. Note whether they were carpooling with anyone and if masks or face-coverings were used during the trip. Advise that they will receive reporting pay for their shift, and HR will contact them.**
